Sulphur Iod 3X

Introduction: A mix of sulphur and iodine, this is a remedy often employed on the basis of clinical concepts denoting a tuberculous terrain (Tuberculinum), with recurrent head colds and bronchitis; laryngitis; enlarged adenoids (Agraphis); and a catarrhal condition in the Eustachian tube. The child sleeps with an open mouth.

This is a very profound and long-acting remedy affecting all parts of the body with aggravations morning, afternoon, evening, NIGHT, and after midnight.

Guiding symptoms/Indications:

- 1. Almost a specific for barber's itch. Cures eczema, when the surface is darkened, swollen, weepy and itches terribly.
- 2. "pustular eruption on upper lip" and "erythema on chin."
- 3. Thickness of tongue remaining after parenchymatous glossitis.
 - -Hypertrophy of parotids after parotitis.
- 4. Uvula and tonsil enlarged and reddened, accumulation of dark purulent mucus in windpipe, mucus removed with difficulty. In the throat feeling as if swelled.
- 5. Itching on ears, nose, and in urethra. Papular eruption on the face. Erythematous breaking out on upper lip, with yellowish pustules, painful, quickly disappearing in dry scales.
- 6. Boils upon anterior part of neck and in vicinity of the mouth. Arms covered with an itching rash like nettle-rash.

Particulars:

Throat.--Uvula and tonsils enlarged and reddened. Swollen. Tongue thick. Parotid hypertrophied.

Skin.--Itching on ears, nose, and in urethra. Papular eruption on face. Cold-sores on lips. Boils on neck. Barber's itch. Acne. Lichen planus. Arms covered with itching rash. Hair feels as if erect.

Pathogenesis:

Dose and administration: 1 tab 3 to 4 times daily. ½ tab for children. **Side effects:** No significant side effect has been observed in proper dosage

Contraindication: There is no known contraindication.

Presentations: 50 tabs (20 gm in PET bottle), 450gm powder in container.
